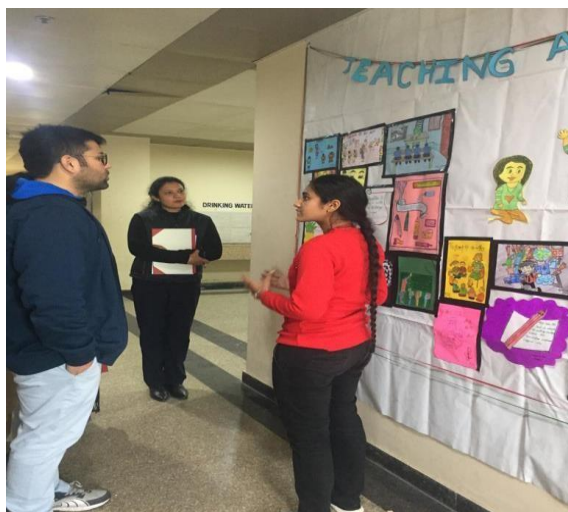
National Army Day
