The members of the BOS discussed and deliberated on the various items of the agenda. The following points emerged out of the meeting:

Item 1: Approval for the Course Schemes of 2021-22 batch and onwards for B.A.B.Ed. and B.Sc.B.Ed. programme.

The Board discussed, revised, and approved the proposed scheme of 2021-22 batch and onwards for B.A.B.Ed. and B.Sc.B.Ed. programme. Following changes have been done.

B.A.B.Ed Programme

- 1. The number of credits in the core course named Elective English/Elective Punjabi/Elective Hindi, History, Geography, Political Science, Economics, Psychology and Sociology should be converted to 5 instead of 6 credits.
- 2. The credits of Perspectives in Education courses should be reduced to 4 in place of 6 credits.
- 3. Subjects like Psychology/Sociology may also be introduced as Generic Elective as per the interest of the students.
- 4. The subject of Gender, School and Society should be added in Perspectives in Education as per guidelines of NCTE.

B.Sc.B.Ed Programme

- 1. The number of credits in the core course named Botany, Zoology, Chemistry, Physics and Mathematics should be converted to 5 (4+1P) instead of 6 credits.
- 2. The credits of Perspectives in Education courses should be converted to 4 credits in B.Sc.B.Ed.
- 3. The subject of Gender, School and Society (Sem-VIII) should be added in Perspectives in Education as per guidelines of NCTE.

Item 2: Approval for the Course content revised under the committee of experts of respective subjects:
