The members of the BoS discussed and deliberated on the various items of the agenda. The following points emerged out of the meeting:

**Item 1:** Approval for the Course Schemes and Syllabi of 2023 batch and onwards for BA English, BA English Honours, BA English Honours with Research and MA English.

The Course Schemes and detailed Syllabi of 2023 batch and onwards for BA English, BA English Honours and BA English Honours with Research, along with Certificate Course in English, Diploma in English according to National Education Policy 2020 (NEP2020) prepared according to National Education Policy 2020 (NEP2020).

The Course Schemes and detailed Syllabi of 2023 batch and onwards for MA English was prepared according to the Choice Based Credit System proposed by UGC. These documents were presented to the Board of Studies for its approval.

The Board discussed, revised and approved the proposed outline of tests, syllabi, and courses of the following programmes for 2023 batch and onwards:

1. BA English (3 Year programme 120 Credits)
2. BA English Honours (4 Year programme 160 Credits)
3. BA English Honours with Research (4 Year programme 160 credits)
4. MA English (2 Year programme)

Dr. Aditya Suggested that the courses content needs streamlining. Moreover, to follow the NEP2020, the texts related to the course maybe reduced as per the department faculty and student needs.

Prof Deepti Gupta suggested that English Departments shall get rid of the label of "British" added to genres of Literature, and shall have just Fiction, Poetry, Drama written in English in any part of the world.

Er. Jagmohan Singh stressed on the need to practice the skills learnt to make the student proficient.


